Chambord is one of the most awe-inspiring Renaissance constructions arousing admiration and fascination throughout the world. Far from serving as a residential palace or a mere hunting lodge, the chateau is a stupendous work of art, imagined by King François I and inspired by Leonardo da Vinci, it has yet to divulge its innermost secrets.

Girded by a 32-kilometer (20-mile) enclosure wall, its 5440-hectare (13400-acre) park contains seemingly innumerable hidden pathways, pristine landscapes, and an exceptionally wide-ranging array of fauna and flora.

Whether you are searching for nature, culture, local products or recreational facilities, Chambord offers a multitude of activities in the chateau or the open air, to be enjoyed in a group, as a family or with friends, unaccompanied or escorted by an enthusiastic guide. Not to mention a copious programme of cultural events that punctuates the seasons...

THE HISTOPAD FOR A NEW RENAISSANCE EXPERIENCE

Spring 2026, a new Renaissance experience will be available to visitors. They will be greeted and guided by King François I on a tour that explores the creative vision that led to the construction of Chambord, a real architectural masterpiece. The touchscreen tablet will offer 14 interactive moments that will immerse visitors in digital reproductions of the rooms as they appeared during the Renaissance. These will be supplemented by more than an hour of audio commentary about the chateau's history and architecture, as well as a fun-filled treasure hunt for young audiences.

FEASTS AT CHAMBORD HERITAGE EXHIBITION

From 26 September 2026 to 24 January 2027, Chambord will be featuring an exhibition dedicated to the Château's culinary history, from the 16th century to today. It will present historic feasts, the evolution of dietary habits, table settings and the art of entertaining. The biggest meals and banquets hosted at the chateau will be reconstructed. From the supper given in honour of Emperor Charles V in 1539 to the gala dinner served for the Prince and Princess of Wales in 1988, visitors will discover tables set with original pieces and outstanding reproductions, accompanied by artwork and documentation for context. In parallel, works of art and rare objects from the chateau's collections will be on display in a museum space, delivering intimate, culinary insight into the world of Chambord.

SUSTAINABLE CHAMBORD



Domaine national de Chambord is actively engaged in the sustainable management of its property, working to conserve its biodiversity and use its resources responsibly (through green grazing, delayed mowing, the preservation of heirloom plants, etc.). Within the estate's forests, meadows and marshes, nature is showcased and protected. Under the chateau de Chambord brand name, the estate sells authentic local products, including wine, organic fruit and vegetables, birch water, venison from regulated deer hunting, honey, and more.

NATURE OUTING IDEA: Private guided tour of the reserve in an all-terrain vehicle to discover the landscapes and history of the park, or the connected nature rally on the outskirts of the chateau, see pages 15 and 16.

CHAMBORD'S SPARKLING WINES

L'Intrigant (Brut White) and La Favorite (Brut Rosé) are two new small-batch wines imbued with delicate bubbles. The white, which comes from Romorantin and Orbois, radiates seductive aromas of yellow fruit, citrus and exotic fruit. The rosé, made from 100% Gamay grapes, exudes charming berry notes. Both of them are wonderful complements to the existing product range, exhibiting lovely, mineral tension and pairing perfectly with any festive occasion. To awaken the taste buds, they can be enjoyed in moderation at any time!

This experience also includes interactive maps, spoken and written commentary on Chambord's history and architecture, and a fun-filled treasure hunt for young audiences.

CHAMBORD WINE, A HISTORIC WINE

A 1515 royal decree informs us that François I had transported from Beaune (Bourgogne) to the Loire Valley 80,000 vine plants of renowned varieties, which were reputedly at the origin of the Romorantin plant. Five hundred years later, organically farmed vines bring together five varieties two kilometers from the chateau over a surface exceeding 14 hectares. Chambord has thereby revived its wine-growing tradition and produces its own wines in eco-certified farmland without artificial yeast additives. Six wines are proposed: two whites (a Romorantin variety stemming from pre-phylloxera grapes and a Sauvignon), two AOC Cheverny reds (black pinoy and Gamay), and two high-quality sparkling wines. They are on sale in the chateau shops or online (boutiquedechambord.fr), and may be tasted in the two restaurant areas of the estate.

FOREST ACTIVITIES

THE LARGEST WALL-ENCLOSED PARK IN EUROPE

Domaine national de Chambord is enclosed by a 32-kilometer wall. The area covers 13,440 acres - the size of the city of Paris. It is home to an exceptionally rich variety of wildlife and is a shrine to France's natural heritage. Deer, wild boars and sheep, salamanders and no fewer than 150 species of birds or rare species of dragonflies, amphibians, chiropterans and insects cohabit with one another in this forest showpiece, registered in the NATURA 2000 network, of which the main objective is the preservation of biodiversity.

A thousand hectares (2500 acres) of forests, trails, prairies and moorlands are fully accessible to the public, while the private portion of the public may be discovered in the company of a guide in an all-terrain vehicle.





PRIVATE GUIDED TOUR OF THE RESERVE

In an all-terrain vehicle accompanied by a nature guide, participants have the privilege of admission to the heart of a reserve generally closed to the public, as they discover the forest (its history and management), the fauna and the flora. To the side of a path, stags, does or boars may be espied. The excursion includes a stopover in the trophy room and a glass of champagne is served to conclude a privileged interlude in a protected natural setting.

SCHOOLS AND GROUPS OF CHILDREN

Intent on the transmission of knowledge, for many years Chambord has proposed for young schoolchildren the discovery of not only the architecture and daily life of the chateau, but also the profuse biodiversity of the park.




