PARKING

GUIDED TOURS OF THE CHÂTEAU

Discover the history of the château and its original function: an architecture at the service of the royal power in the Renaissance. You will discover the royal residence and be admitted to spaces usually closed to the public (mezzanines, framing structures...).

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Château opening hours

The château is open all year round, except on 1 January, the last Monday of November and 25 December.

- High season: from April to October: 9am 6pm
- Low season: from November to March: 9am 5pm


Last admission 30 min before the château closes. The French formal gardens are closed 30 min before the château.



Access

Under two hours south of Paris and 20 minutes from Blois.

- Highway A10, exit Mer (n°16) or Blois (n°17)
- Highway A85, exit Selles-sur-Cher (n°13)
- Highway A71, exit Lamotte-Beuvron (n°3)
- Closest cities: Blois 20 minutes away, Tours and Orléans one hour away
- Loire vineyards open to tourists, Chocolaterie Max Vauché, Atelier St Michel (cake factory)...
