

# Make your way along kilometres of hidden paths, admire pure, unspoilt landscapes and breathe deep in the midst of a historic forest...

Chambord is Europe's largest walled park, covering 5,440 hectares, more than 1,000 of which are accessible all comers. Over 30 kilometres of cycle paths extend the Loire à Vélo route, and as many pedestrian pathways are at walkers' disposal.



Open every day of the year except on 1 January, the last Monday of November and 25 December, from 9 a.m. Timetables on chambord.org.

# Closing times

- 5:00 p.m.: 1 January to 24 March and 30 October to 15 December
- 6:00 p.m.: 25 March to 29 October and during Christmas school holidays

Last access ½ hour before the Château closes. The French gardens close ½ hour earlier.
