Wine and terroir of the Loire Valley in a privatized room of the chateau



In collaboration with the Wine House at Chambord, participants are introduced to the diversity of the vineyard and the richness of the terroir through the discovery and tasting of 3 wines from the AOC of Cheverny and Cour-Cheverny: two white wines and the red wine of Chambord.

The AOC Cour-Cheverny is produced from a single variety the "Romorantin", introduced in the Loire Valley by François I and planted about thirty kilometers from Chambord, near the chateau of Romorantin.

These wines will no longer have secrets for the group.

The Loire Valley is the 3rd largest appellation region in France, with a total of 85 appellations and denominations. The area has been awarded UNESCO World Heritage status – one of only ten European winegrowing regions distinguished in this way.

THE SERVICE (45 min):

- Presentation of the AOC (controlled designation of origin) Cheverny and Cour-Cheverny in a privatized room of the château.
- Tasting of 3 wines:
 - 1 white wine (AOC Cheverny)
 - 1 white wine (AOC Cour-Cheverny)
 - 1 red wine produced at Chambord (AOC Cheverny Pinot noir and Gamay grapes)

The tasting is accompanied by 4 toasts of local products.
