

THE DOMAIN AND THE FOREST PARK



Explore the forest with its landscapes steeped in history, where every undergrowth, pond, moor and meadow is home to remarkable biodiversity.

Chambord is Europe's largest walled park, covering 5,440 hectares, more than 1,000 of which are accessible to all comers. Over 30 kilometres of cycle paths extend the Loire à Vélo route, and as many pedestrian pathways are at visitors' disposal.

THE KING AND THE EMPEROR

NEW HORSE SHOW





Mario Luraschi and Cavalcade have created an equestrian show that brings to life five centuries of Chambord's history through epic scenes and immersive tableaux.

In 2025, a new show directed by Mario Luraschi will take visitors on a historical journey through Chambord's 500-year history, from François I to the present day.

Stunts and giant screen projections will plunge visitors into an immersive, daring show with a touch of humour that will delight all generations.

Mario Luraschi and Cavalcade have a single motto: action and rhythm! Dresseur, stuntman, horseman, driver, acrobat... Mario Luraschi is renowned for his expertise in stunts and action scenes, both in films (Le Comte de Monte-Cristo, Les Trois Mousquetaires, etc.) and on stage.



December to 3 January 2026; 9 am-4 pm 24 and 31 December.
