Chambord is one of the most awe-inspiring Renaissance constructions arousing admiration and fascination throughout the world. Far from serving as a residential palace or a mere hunting lodge, the chateau is a stupendous work of art; imagined by King François I and inspired by Leonardo da Vinci, it has yet to divulge its innermost secrets.

Girded by a 32-kilometer (20-mile) enclosure wall, its 5440-hectare (13400-acre) park contains seemingly innumerable hidden pathways, pristine landscapes, and an exceptionally wide-ranging array of fauna and flora.

Whether you are searching for nature, culture, local products or recreational facilities, Chambord offers a multitude of activities in the chateau or the open air, to be enjoyed in a group, as a family or with friends, unaccompanied or escorted by an enthusiastic guide. Not to mention a copious program of cultural events that punctuates the seasons...

### **BOTTICELLI: TWO MADONNAS AT CHAMBORD**

Two works from the workshop of the Italian painter Sandro Botticelli are being exhibited in the chapel of the chateau: "The Virgin and the Child with the young Saint John the Baptist", along with its model created several years before and currently conserved in the Palais Pitti of Florence. The grouping of the two pictures illustrates the influence in the Loire Valley of Italian artists including Leonardo da Vinci, whose works inspired the architecture of Chambord.

#### SUSTAINABLE CHAMBORD



Chambord has made a commitment to the conservation of traditional species (black bee of Sologne, Sologne ewe) and to sustainable development actions (eco-grazing in the prairies, reasoned mowing....). Products manufactured in accordance with best practices from the natural resources of the estate are offered for sale under the Chambord brand.

The "Château de Chambord" brand commercializes honey, game terrine, wooden objects from the forest of Chambord, stag antlers, leather goods, birch sap, and Chambord cosmetics as well as wine. Organically farmed vines have been planted, yielding two white wines, two red wines, and two sparkling wines.

**NATURE OUTING IDEA:** Private guided tour of the reserve in an all-terrain vehicle to discover the landscapes and history of the park, or the connected nature rally on the outskirts of the chateau, see pages 15 and 16.



### Did you know?

A 6-bell carillon installed in one of the keeps resonates several times a day in the courtyard and the outskirts of the chateau. The visitor is warmly welcomed by harmonious melodies including the "Chambord" and traditional Christmas tunes as December nears.

### CHAMBORD WINE, A HISTORIC WINE

A 1515 royal decree informs us that François I had transported from Beaune (Bourgogne) to the Loire Valley 80,000 vine plants of renowned varietals, which were reputedly at the origin of the Romorantin plant. Five hundred years later, organically farmed vines bring together five varietals two kilometers from the chateau over a surface exceeding 14 hectares. Chambord has thereby revived its wine-growing tradition and produces its own wines in eco-certified farmland without artificial yeast additives. Six wines are proposed: two whites (a Romorantin varietal stemming from pre-phylloxera grapes and a Sauvignon), two AOC Cheverny reds (black pinoy and Gamay), and two highquality sparkling wines. They are on sale in the chateau shops and on-line (boutiquedechambord.fr), and may be tasted in the two restaurant areas of the estate.

### THE LARGEST WALL-ENCLOSED PARK IN EUROPE

The National Estate of Chambord is enclosed by a 32-kilometer wall. The area covers 13,440 acres - the size of the city of Paris. It is home to an exceptionally rich variety of wildlife and is a shrine to France's natural heritage. Deer, wild boars and sheep, salamanders and no less than 150 species of birds or rare species of dragonflies, amphibians, chiropterans and insects cohabit with one another in this forest showpiece, registered in the NATURA 2000 network, of which the main objective is the preservation of biodiversity.

A thousand hectares (2500 acres) of forests, trails, prairies and moorlands are fully accessible to the public, while the private portion of the public may be discovered in the company of a guide in an all-terrain vehicle.






